Dear Ms. Logan,

The Association of Georgia Surveyors respectfully requests that the GSCCA notify all its membership of the very important opinion of the Attorney General relative to recording plats of surveys.

On December 20, 2005, the Hon. Thurbert E. Baker, Attorney General, rendered the following unofficial opinion...

"Therefore the Clerk of superior court is mandated by law to file and record in the real property records of the superior court any plat meeting the requirements of O.C.G.A. §15-6-67(b) and (d), whether or not such plat meets any other requirements which may have been imposed by a local government."

Accordingly, the Association of Georgia Surveyors asks that all Superior Court clerks throughout Georgia be made aware of this opinion.
